**SUBJECT:** Appointment of Alternate Representatives to the Riverside County Indian Gaming Local Community Benefit Committee


**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors appoint the following individuals as alternate representatives to the Riverside County Indian Gaming Local Community Benefit Committee

**BACKGROUND:** As provided for in Senate Bill 621, each county's Indian Gaming Local Community Benefit Committee (CBC) is to be comprised: two (2) county representatives appointed by the Board of Supervisors; two (3) elected representatives from cities located within 4 miles of a tribal casino in the county; and two (2) representatives selected upon recommendation of the majority of tribes in the county paying into the State Special Distribution Fund.

The first meeting of the Riverside County CBC was held on January 26, 2004. At that meeting, the Committee endorsed the appointment of alternates to the representative categories (i.e., county, cities, and tribes).

It is recommended that Supervisor Jim Venable be appointed as the county representative alternate and City of Indio Councilman Mike Wilson be appointed as the cities representative alternate.
