

SUBJECT: APPOINTMENT TO RIVERSIDE COUNTY INDIAN GAMING  
LOCAL COMMUNITY BENEFIT COMMITTEE

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors appoint the following individuals to the Riverside County Indian Gaming Local Community Benefit Committee:

Supervisor John Tavaglione - Riverside County  
Supervisor Marion Ashley - Riverside County  
Councilman Ron Roberts - City of Temecula  
Mayor Ron Oden - City of Palm Springs  
Mayor Art Welch - City of Banning

BACKGROUND: In accordance with SB 621 (Battin/Burton), a percentage of the funds generated through tribal gaming will be deposited into a Special Distribution Fund (SDF), which will then be distributed in the form of grants to local governments that may be impacted by tribal gaming. Grant application review and disbursement from the fund will be managed by the County in which the tribal casinos are located. The legislation further requires that a formal committee known as the Indian Gaming Local Benefit Committee be established by the County. The committee shall consist of 2 county representatives, 3 city representatives (whose cities have a casino in operation within 4 miles of their jurisdiction), and 2 tribal representatives, selected by tribal members. The county and city representatives are to be selected by the Board of Supervisors. The above recommendation provides for the city/county representatives for the 2004 calendar year.
